

Regular readers and Festival followers will know that we are performing Handel's "Messiah" at Ripon A stunning venue and a Cathedral. work much loved by audiences and singers alike. There'll be a period instrument orchestra and four acclaimed soloists - Rowan Pierce (soprano), William Towers (alto), Nicholas Pritchard (tenor) and Nicholas Mogg (bass).

Weekly rehearsals are going well, with the two choirs practising separately for now and then joining together for our last couple of sessions before the big day in the cathedral. We're expecting the combined choir will number about eighty, making it an amazing experience for all the singers - and hopefully for the audience as well.







Sustainable Swaledale

Dales couple produce carbon neutral beef on upland farm

Article on a couple farming near Orton, who are producing certified carbon neutral beef. They have reduced their sheep numbers and lambed later, increased cattle numbers and stopped buying in fertilisers and feed, adopted new grassland management techniques and planted trees and hedges.

Composting without a garden.

Elizabeth asked in a letter to the March Reeth Gazette what one can do with vegetable peelings if you don't have a garden with a compost heap? Richmondshire District Council doesn't offer a food waste collection - perhaps something one could lobby for? Leyburn Household Waste Recycling Centre takes food waste but as it goes for incineration, you might as well put it in your grey bin. There is no central location in Reeth for composting but you might find a neighbour happy to take

uncooked food waste if you ask around.

Flat occupiers claim to successfully compost uncooked food waste using a worm bin or vermicomposter. For those with access to a small outside space, other options include electric composters (which can also take cooked food) and bokashi bins.

Should you have space to compost but are not sure how to start, North Yorkshire Council offers composting bins at a discount and a volunteer group, the North Yorkshire Rotters, promote home composting. https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/north-yorkshire-rotters





Transform rural verges into Living Verges... by Friends of the Dales

With spring in sight we are once again turning our focus back to our Living Verges campaign. As the growing season gets underway, we'll be watching to see whether there have been any noticeable changes in verge cutting as a result of our conversations with North Yorkshire County Council and supporting more villages become nature positive through a policy of: 'Cut less - Cut later - Take away'. Remember, rural verges are often remnants of vanished



Dales hay meadows and if better managed will regenerate into flower rich, biodiverse havens for insects and birds. Species rich verges also store more carbon than 'neat and tidy' verges.

We aim to follow any changes in Dales verges over time, so we'd welcome any photos or other information that could help supplement our evidence. Our campaign covers not just verges, but any piece of village grassland, such as churchyards and greens. Small changes can make a big difference - there is the potential to have a significant positive effect on biodiversity by adopting a few of the simple



North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service

After what can only be described as a horrifically turbulent month for the world, our thoughts in particular are with Ukraine's emergency service workers.

Reeth Station

Last month following our previous article on road safety we got three call-outs in one day, to attend multiple incidents of stranded occupants of vehicles in floodwater after passing through road closures. If you come across "road closed due to flooding" signage DO NOT ignore it.

Training Update

We received a very generous offer of a building, under renovation within Reeth, to be used as a training location in March. One of the crew members set up a scenario placing dummies to be rescued and organising various hazards. The building was then filled with simulated smoke and a drill was run in real time by the crew. Teams entered the property on a search and rescue mission locating casualties and providing the following teams with information to aid them in their task. No sooner had we packed all equipment away a call came through and we had to shoot off for a suspected boiler fire. Never a dull moment!

Automating the Grinton church clock

The Parish Church of St. Andrew was extensively renovated in 1896 although the main footprint of the church dates back to Norman times - it gets a mention in the Domesday book! The church has strong links back to Bridlington Priory despite the distance between the buildings and the district boundaries that would have been crossed in those days.

During the intervening time, the church has been active in the dale and there are many memorable markers to its age and importance within the local community. There are various historic features such as the double-sided William and Mary coat of arms, the Norman font with its mediaeval cover and a considerable amount οf mediaeval stained glass. The fabric of the church is maintained locally and is the responsibility of the church members. It is governed through the Church of England's planning authority which lies within our Diocese of Leeds.

The bell tower houses a turret clock made by a famous local clockmaker, William Potts of Leeds.

William was born in December 1809 in Salt Yard, Bondgate, Darlington. His father Robert was apprenticed to a Darlington clockmaker in 1790. William followed in his footsteps and was apprenticed to Samuel Thompson, a Darlington clockmaker. Then, aged 24, he moved to Pudsey and established his own clockworks. In 1862, the business moved to Leeds. The company was granted a Royal Warrant by Queen Victoria in 1897, the year after the clock was installed in the tower at St An-

drew's.

Three of William's sons joined the firm. Robert eventually headed the firm whilst his brothers Tom and Charles both left to establish their own clockmaking business in 1928 and 1930 respectively.



In 1935 William Potts and Sons joined the Smith of Derby Group and the link with Smith's is maintained via an annual clock service funded by the St. Andrew's church to this day.

After a long and faithful service of weekly clock winding by Tom Guy which only ceased upon his death, the clock is now wound each week by volunteers. ! This is a task which should be automated as fewer volunteers are available for this weekly task and, like the clock, they seem to be getting older every year. At St. Andrew's, the mechanism has an 8-day drive mechanism which means physically rewinding the clock every week. It also needs careful re-setting twice yearly when the clocks change, and this is a relatively complex process. The motive force comes from three weights which have long drop into (see next page)
